1911: The mythic steps...

Paris (Issy-les-Moulineaux)

May 21: 4 competitors take off, the race begins.

May 22: Jules Védrines takes part in the race on a Morane Saulnier.



San Sebastian - Spain May 25: 3 competitors fly away, Garros and Gibert must abandon the race close to San Sebastian.

Burgos - Spain

May 25: After a minor mishap, Jules Védrines stops for the night.

Madrid (Getafe)

May 26: Jules Védrines arrives triumphant in Getafe.
